Entry requirements will vary dependant upon the background of individual students. Year 12 students should check with the Institutions whether they need to apply through VTAC or by direct entry.

Non Year 12 students should check to see if they qualify for Special Entry Schemes. Students should check with the individual institutions or the VTAC website www.vtac.edu.au. It is possible that students may have prior experience recognised for relevant units of the course. Further information should be sought from the Institution.

Many TAFE Institutes offer short courses such as Forklift Driving, Food Safety for Supervisors that may provide additional skills for intended or current employment. Short course information is available from each institution.

Note 1

Year 12 students need to apply through VTAC for entry to the above courses. Offers may be based upon the ENTER and other criteria such as interviews. Intending students should check the latest VTAC information on courses (www.vtac.edu.au) as course titles, content, delivery mode and location may change.

Note 2

(PG) indicates coursework graduate and/or postgraduate programs may be available in study areas of interest. Many of these programs are designed for recent and more mature graduates to increase their knowledge of specialty areas. The course may be offered in residential schools and/or by off campus study to assist persons who are already working. Some programs such as Executive Certificate course permit people without a formal tertiary study background to enter the course.

Note 3

With the new undergraduate programs offered by the University of Melbourne, food science and agriculture may be taken as elective study streams in the Bachelor of Science.
